Wind and Solar are privately funded.

- Renewable energy companies invest hundreds of millions of dollars into local communities.



Wind and solar provide millions of dollars in new revenue to struggling rural communities.

- White County has received over \$11 million from wind projects to date – and has more on the way.
- Randolph County was able to upgrade their school facilities from money they received and both Randolph and Benton Counties were able to expand access to broadband internet.

- Wind and Solar are the lowest cost form of energy available.
- Major corporations like Subaru, Cummins, Amazon, Google, Facebook, Salesforce and many more view access to renewable energy as a priority.
